
The number of new users, sessions, and session duration increased whereas pages viewed per session decreased slightly. Consistent with previous quarters, nearly half of visitors accessed the site on a mobile device. Most patrons continue to find materials via organic search, indicating digital collections remain easily accessible to search engines.



Social Media

Social Media remains an important component of outreach. Posts on Facebook, Instagram, and Twitter allow staff to share materials and interact with the community. With one exception, post reactions, comments, shares, and impressions increased across all platforms this quarter. Engagement rates were slightly lower on Facebook and Instagram. An emphasis on sharing more content from the 1960s through the 1990s likely contributed to the substantial increase in comments and shares on Facebook.



Videos produced by Carnegie continue to be popular on YouTube. Six of the top twenty videos this quarter feature the Maria Rogers Oral History Program (MROHP). *MROHP Shorts: Hippie Invasion, Boulder, CO* is a perpetual favorite and takes the top spot with 576 views and 23 shares.

Digital Public Library of America (DPLA)

This quarter, 191 sessions were recorded with 106 users and 312 click throughs to Carnegie's site. These numbers represent small (13% or less) increases from Q2. Visitors spanned thirteen states (up from eleven), as well as Italy and Australia. Materials generating click throughs include several glass plate slide images and interviews from the Maria Rogers Oral History Program.
